-  Each MEA member may submit **one** essay written by one of their students.
-  Essays must be original student work, edited for capitalization, punctuation and spelling. Essays must be typed and double spaced.
-  Essays must be received by Kathleen Olwy at Munsey Park School Library Media Center by Friday, February 7, 2014.
-  A committee of teachers will select one Manhasset winner for each of the 4 following grade level categories: K-2, 3-5, Middle School Grades 6-8, and High School Grades 9-12.
-  The MEA will award those 4 students a \$50.00 gift card from Barnes & Noble and their essays will be forwarded to the LIPC competition.
-  Eight students chosen by LIPC as semifinalists will win a check for \$250.00.
-  Four students chosen by LIPC as winners will win a \$500.00 check, and their essays will be recorded and played on the radio.

We have had great participation from all four buildings in past years. Manhasset has had winners at both the semifinalist and finalist levels.
